


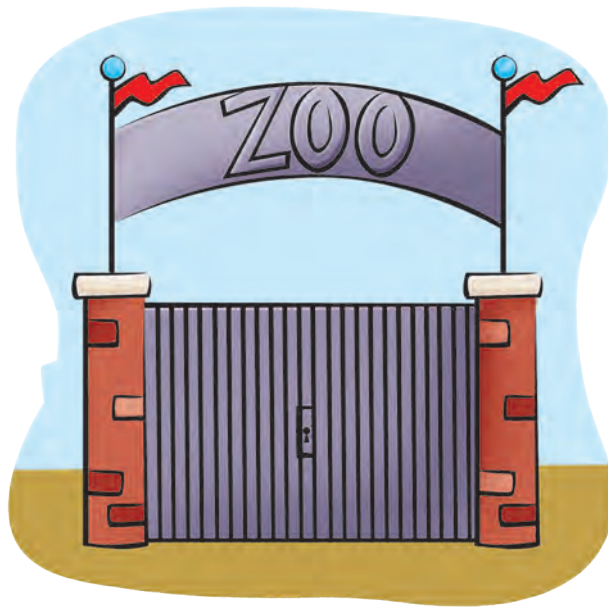
Lesson 3 Point of View

Get the Idea

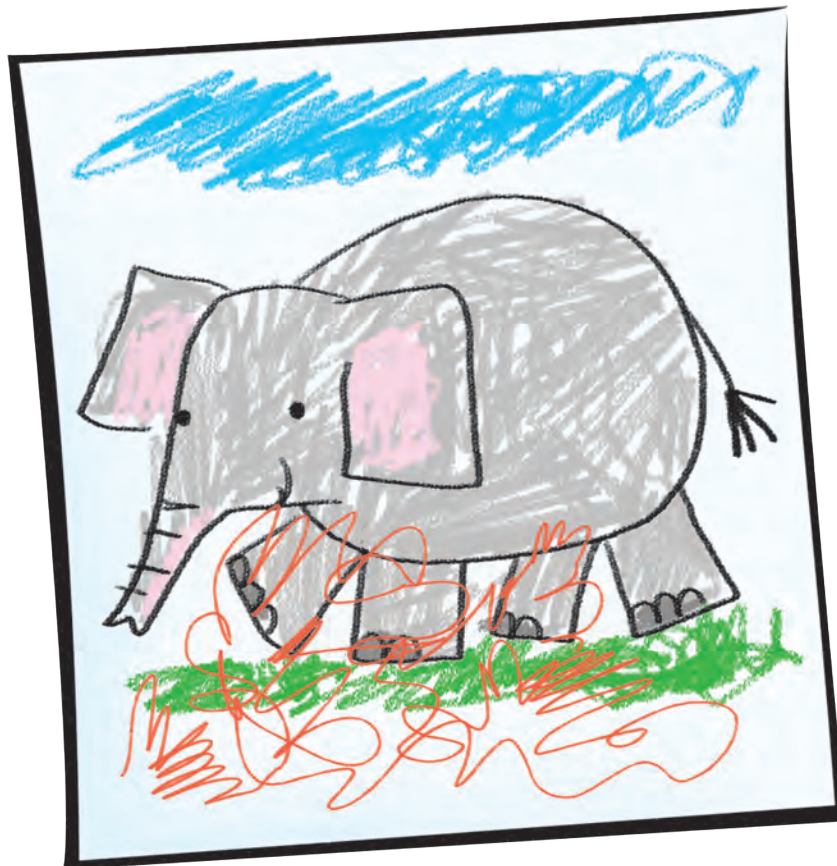
Randy's Sad Day
